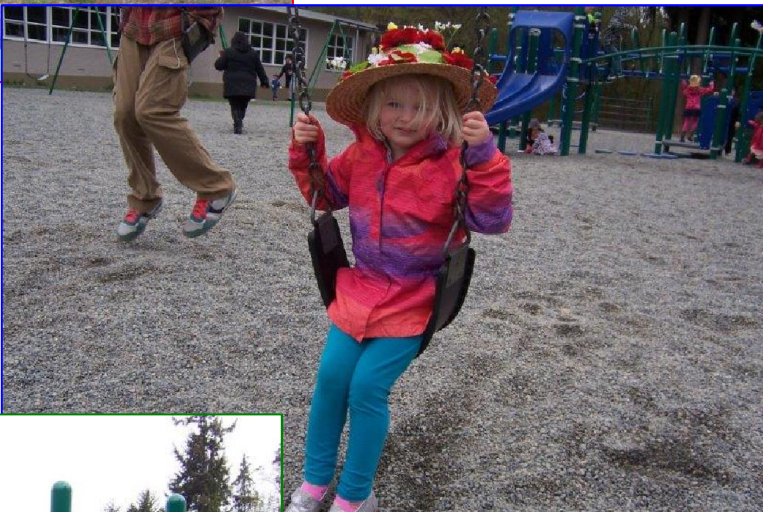


And, of course, there was the ever-so-popular Easter Bonnet competition.
