Foundation Beginnings

- Foundation Started December 1972 by Harold Whitfield
 - Original intent – to allow contributions to the club to be tax deductible
 - What actually happened – most contributions came from fundraising (until later years)
- Early Years Giving
 - Most grants were awarded in the form of scholarships



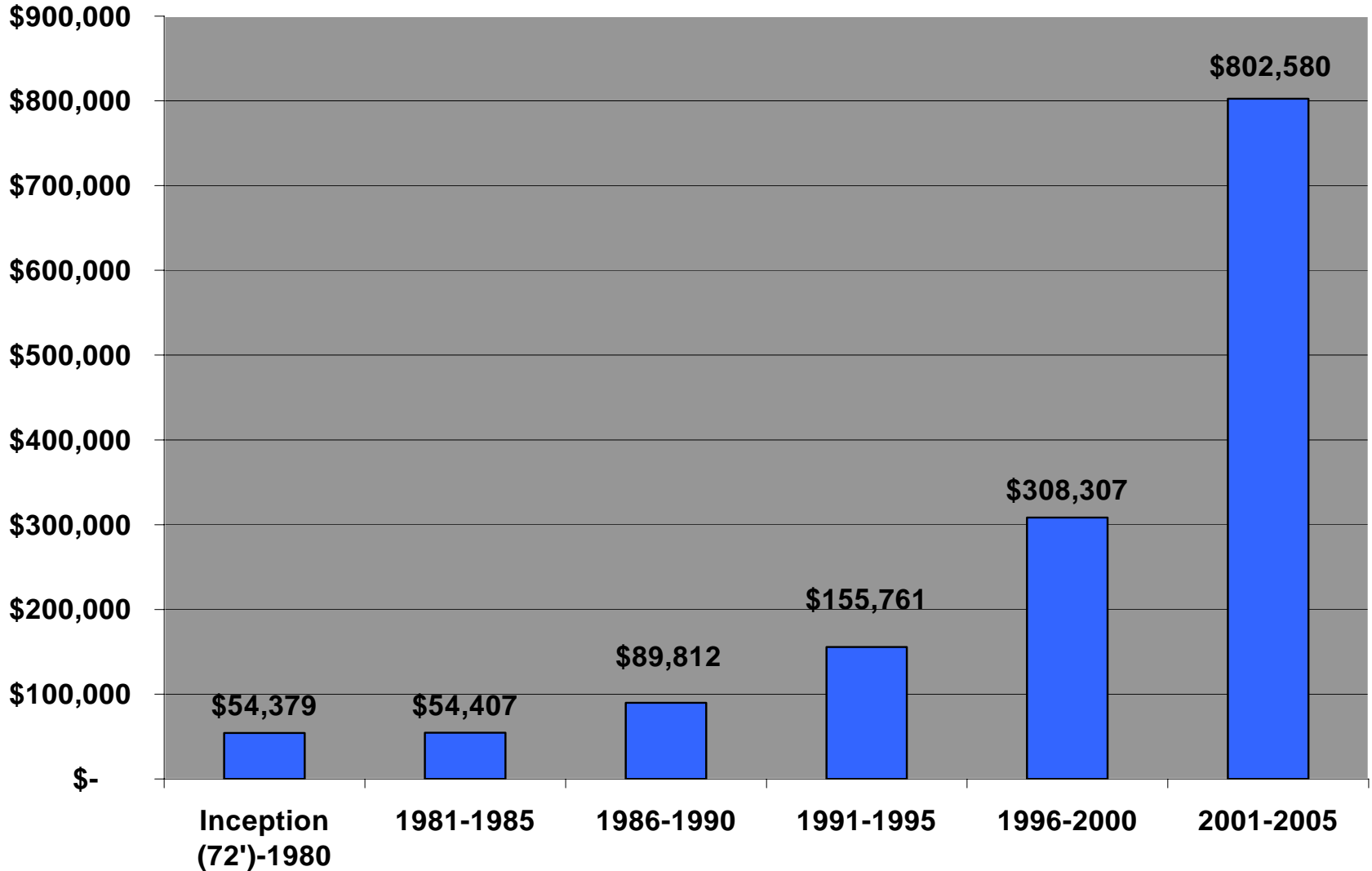

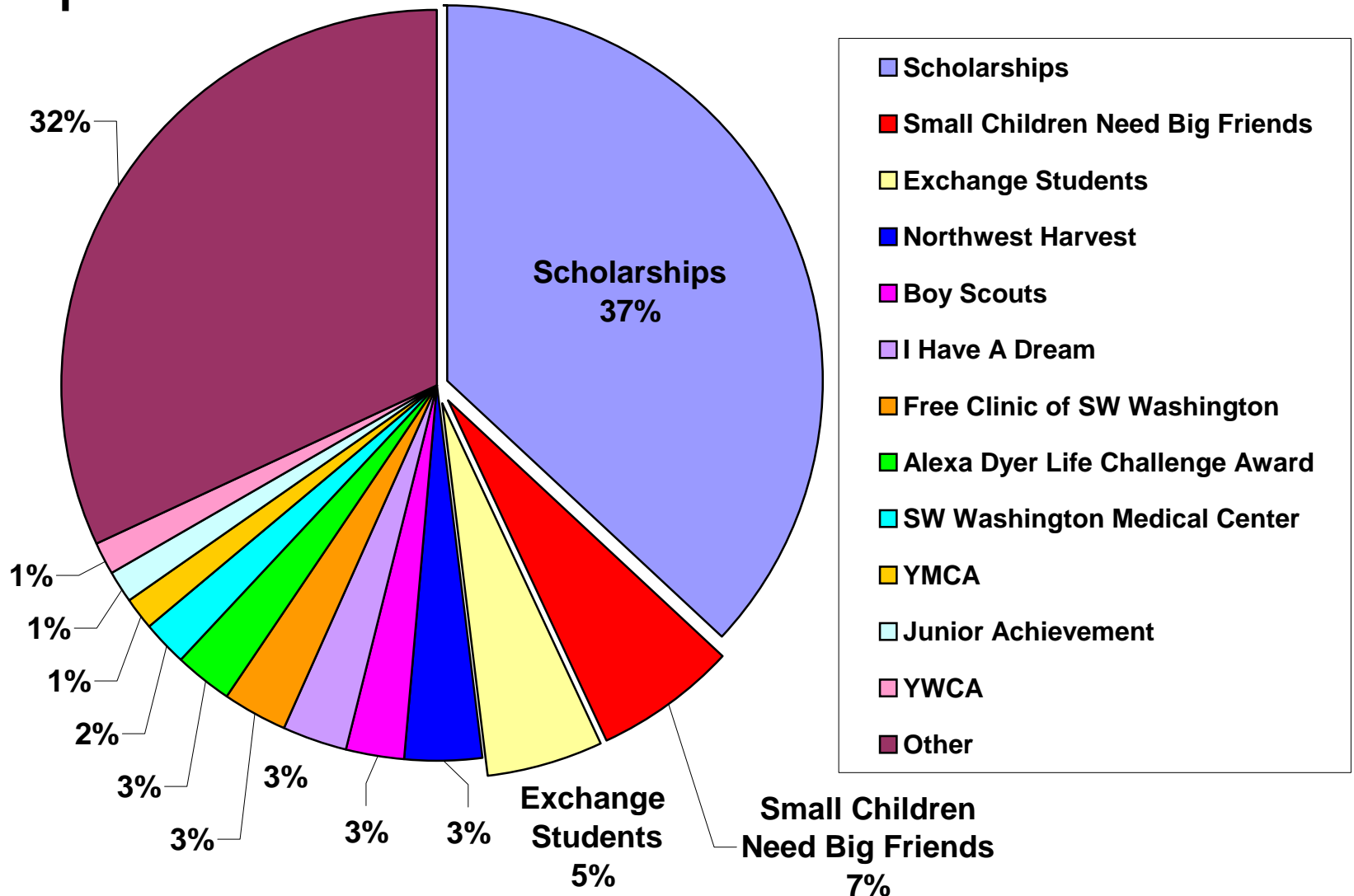

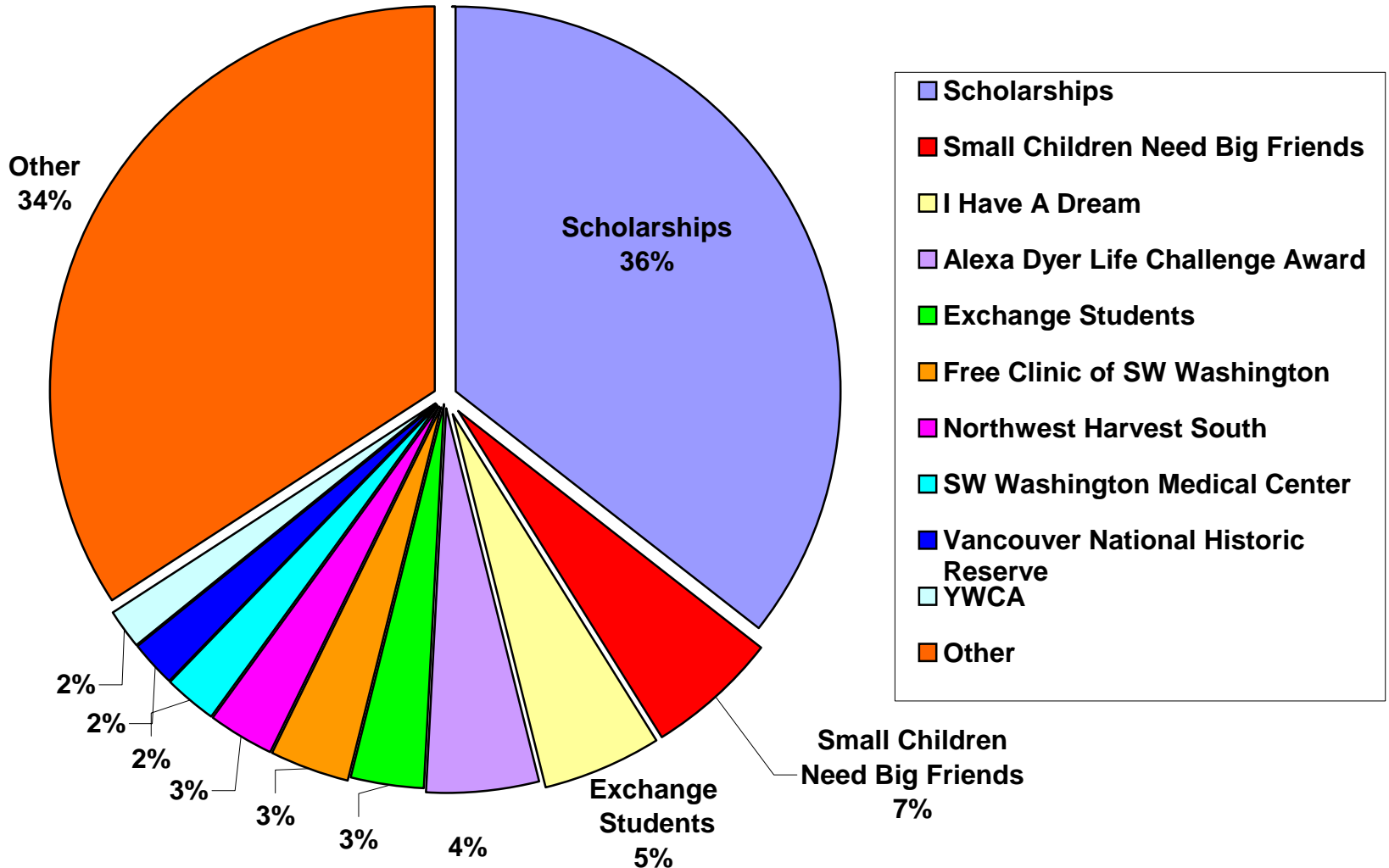
