

Youth Protection Officer (YPO) Job Description

The position of Youth Protection Officer within the club was created to ensure that the club is actively fulfilling the requirements contained in the Youth Protection Policy; to keep club management informed of any issues affecting Youth Services and Youth Protection activities; and to ensure that club members have fulfilled their individual requirements under the policy.

The YPO will ensure that the club maintains its status as a Certified Club within the Districts Youth Protection Policy Requirements.

The YPO will ensure that the Club President Elect and the Club Youth Services Chair are both Certified Rotarians, and have signed and submitted the Club Youth Protection Certification Form prior to taking office on July 1, of each year; or date designated by the District Governor Elect.

The YPO will work with all members of the club to ensure that all Rotarians have taken the Youth Protection Awareness course.

The YPO will monitor District Records to ensure that individual requirements have been met.

The YPO will remind and ensure that those who require more than the minimum training, due to their club or district job assignments, have fulfilled their requirements.
