

**The Rotary Club of Thousand Oaks  
Official Raffle Rules**

1. **Location and Date:** The Rotary Club of Thousand Oaks Raffle will be held on August 23, 2009, at approximately 6:30 pm at the Westlake Village Inn 31943 Agoura Rd. Westlake Village, CA 91362

2. **Prizes:** The drawing will include the following prizes: 1st prize– 5 day and 4 night including airfare and car rental, and 2 tickets to a luau – 2<sup>nd</sup> prize - \$500 Shopping Spree at the Oaks Shopping Mall in Thousand Oaks, CA, 4 tickets to Muvico and \$100 Gift Certificate to Bogarts; Third prize is a \$250.00 Gift Certificate to Mastro's Steakhouse.

3. **Tickets & Donations:** Drawing tickets will be available beginning June 25, 2009, until immediately prior to the drawing either through distribution at Rotary events, through distribution by individual Rotarians, or at A Midsummer Eve Wine and Art event. The donation for drawing tickets is \$20.00 per ticket. Donations cannot be refunded. A free ticket may be obtained during the golf tournament at the check-in desk at the golf club or by sending a stamped self-addressed envelope to:

4. **Winners:** Winners need not be present and will be contacted to claim their prizes based on the information on the ticket stub. Identification of winners will be made by the Wine and Art Committee, and positive identification will be required. In the event the person whose name is on the winning ticket is a minor, presentation of the prize will be made only to the minor's legal guardian. Every reasonable effort will be made to contact the winners, however if a winner does not respond to claim the prize within 60 days of the initial contact attempt, or declines to accept the prize, the prize will be forfeited and will be retained by the Golf Committee.

By participation in the drawing and winning a prize, winners agree to allow the use of their names for publication purposes, as well as of photographs which may be taken of them relative to the drawing and/or awarding of the drawing prize.

5. **Delivery of Prizes:** Prizes will be delivered at a time mutually agreed upon by each of the winners and the Wine and Art Committee.

6. **Eligibility:** Participation in the drawing is open to the general public, The Rotary Club of Thousand Oaks Rotarians, including members of the Wine and Art Committee, Chairperson(s), and their immediate families.

By participating in the drawing each person entering a ticket agrees to abide by all decisions made by such Chairperson.
