Last Week's Meeting: Kristin Taylor, on short notice, led us in the salute to our flag, an invocation, a patriotic song and introductions. President Emrich then took over, making announcements regarding Coats 4 Kids, it's committee meeting at 11:30 a.m. before next week's meeting and other matters, then calling upon Dick Hatcher, who awarded a well deserved Paul Harris Fellowship to Captain Bill Finley, pictured. Kathy McCleery, chair of the Polio Plus Committee, explained how close we were to worldwide eradication, but that if the disease was not eliminated polio could resurge to more than 10 million cases in less than 20 years. Mark Kirwin, pictured, recent Master PRLS graduate, gave a compelling speech about his training. Larry then told us that Hutch Hutchison had agreed to become our new



President Elect, and that this was approved by the Board after recommendations by our Nominating Committee, Terry Schaeffer, Everett Millais and Roger Case. Following Happy Dollars, including a poignant one by Betsy Chess, Ed McCombs introduced our program, Ventura Public Works Director Ron Calkins, pictured. Ron explained the history of the water supply for the City of Ventura, dating back to the Mission Acqueduct system capturing, storing and conveying water from the Ventura River to our city, working well until a new system was adopted in 1886. Ron explained how the system was improved and expanded many times thereafter to include water from Lake Casitas, groundwater from the East Ventura area and an ace in the hole, State Water Project entitlement.
