OUR PROGRAM: Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)

Incoming club president and program chair **Dr. Denise Ellis** introduced our Rotary Club sojourner **Sherre Calouri**. Sherre is currently a consultant with an educational consulting firm providing professional services in strategic planning, conflict resolution, communications, board governance, systems audits, and professional workshops to public and private schools, K - 12. She is also a Disaster Assistance Employee with the Federal Emergency Management Agency in External Affairs. She presented an exceptionally interesting and informative PowerPoint presentation entitled "My Life with FEMA". She covered the history and mission of FEMA, its organization, and her role within FEMA. She was first hired in 2004, and her first assignment was in response to Hurricane Katrina, where she worked in Baton Rouge. The terms of her employment are that she has to be available for at least 60 days per year, and she also has to commit to 30 days, if called. She has worked flooding disasters in New York, Arkansas, West Virginia, North Dakota, Kentucky and Oregon, and hurricane disasters in Louisiana and Mississippi. She finally shared these extremely important tips for survival in a disaster:

- Be prepared to shelter in place for 72 hours
- Evacuate if you are ordered to do so
- Have a plan to contact family. Contact point should be out of state. Text messages are more likely to be delivered than voice calls
- Contact your city for more detailed information
