OUR PROGRAM

Dr. Denise Ellis introduced **Mitch Blumberg**, the Deputy Executive Director of Desert Arc, and a member of the Palm Desert Rotary. Desert Arc is one of the largest and oldest (53 years) non-profit agencies based in the Coachella Valley. It provides social services, vocational training and employment

opportunities for 600 developmentally disabled adults from its central campus at Montereyand Country Club in Palm Desert, its satellite campus in YuccaValley, and its new recycling operation in Indio. Mr. Blumberg stressed the close ties that its clients have with many Coachella Valley institutions, such as both Eisenhower and Desert Regional medical centers, COSTCO, WalMart, many area golf courses, Joshua TreeNational Park, and several other businesses. They also provide fulfillment and distribution services at their main campus for companies such as Time Warner. Their fleet of vehicles rivals Sun Bus, with 27 large busses and 18 vans.
