**Anita Grey** (glad to see you back!) introduced Gwen Ford, Stakeholder and Volunteer Coordinator for FIND. Ms. Ford presented a comprehensive view of this organization, which is responsible for providing approximately 80,000 meals per month to the needy throughout the area from Beaumont through the high desert to Blythe (including the Coachella Valley, of course). Staffing includes 14 full time employees, plus a cadre of volunteers. Among FIND's many partners are Well of the Desert, Martha's Village, the Coachella Valley Rescue Mission, the Salvation Army, Catholic Charities, Boys and Girls Clubs, and the YMCA. It is a part of the "Feeding America" program consisting of 250 organizations nationwide. Our District's "Million Meals" program will work with FIND to accomplish our goals.
