Background

Rotary is an organization of business and professional leaders united worldwide, who provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations, and help build goodwill and peace in the world. There are approximately 1.2 million Rotarians, members of more than 29,000 Rotary Clubs in 161 countries. The enthusiasm with which Rotarians embrace the ideal of service is evidenced by Rotary's principal motto, "Service Above Self" and its other official precept, "He Profits Most Who Serves Best."

The Swan City Rotary club is made up of more than 100 men and women representing a large cross section of the business and professional community.

These guidelines are intended to help applicants understand our policies, guidelines, and requirements that will factor into our decision making.

Objectives

The Swan City Rotary Club has the following objectives it hopes to achieve through its Lottery Partnerships.

- Support will focus on projects and activities that address:
 - Education & literacy
 - At risk or underprivileged youth
 - Health & welfare

 - Sports groups
 - Culture and the Arts
 - Environment
 - Seniors
 - Support for Rotary International humanitarian and educational programs and activities

Guidelines

The following criteria will provide the basis for assessing all requests presented to the Swan City Rotary Club (in no particular order)

- The match with Rotary's focus areas
- Importance of need
- Degree to which the proposed project can demonstrate a significant impact
- Number and location of people to be served
- Local organizational history
- The ability to meet volunteer requirements
- Funding sources (other fundraisers, municipal, provincial or federal government etc.)
- Partners shall not participate in conflicting Lotteries exceeding \$25,000 in prizes

We generally do not provide funding for:

- Organizations that are for profit
- Individuals
- Organizations who have received funding through other partnerships with the Swan City Rotary Club (direct or indirect)
- Political or legislative campaigns
- Religious organizations or church sponsored programs limited to church membership
- Ongoing operating costs
