**UTILIZATION OF DISTRICT ACCUMULATED
ROTARY FOUNDATION RECOGNITION POINTS**

OBJECTIVE:

The objective of this initiative is to make the most effective use of the District's accumulated Rotary Foundation recognition points for the promotion of the good, and the benefit of Rotary throughout District 5550

PROPOSAL:

It is proposed to make available one Paul Harris award to each club in the District per year (that requests it) until the points are depleted. This would achieve the above objective by:

- Encouraging clubs to use the recognition to promote Rotary within both the club and the community
- Encouraging clubs to use the District Governor's visit or some other special event to present this recognition

PROCESS:

It is up to club presidents to take advantage of this initiative. The Paul Harris award would be made available upon request from the club. The selection criteria for this recognition are at the discretion of the club.

Club presidents are responsible for:

- Completing The Rotary Foundation Recognition/Contribution Recognition Form (sections III and IV),
- Sending it to the District Chair of the Rotary Foundation for completion of sections I and II

The District Foundation Committee Chair will sign and send the completed form to TRF Canada at the following address: Rotary Foundation (Canada) Box B9322, P.O. Box 9100, Postal Station F. Toronto, Ontario M4Y 3A5.

The Foundation recognition items will come to the club for presentation to the recipient. A 4 – 6 week period is needed between selection and presentation.
