Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? The Backpack program prepares weekend meals to school-age students. Meals are packaged in bags and distributed to the participating schools where they are placed in backpacks so the children can take the food home with some confidentiality. The meals are prepared at the Great Plains Food Bank in Fargo.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 10-12 on a monthly basis

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Put together weekend meal bags from a nutritional lunch to be sent out schools for children who would otherwise be hungry over the weekend.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 750 children receive food on a weekly basis.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Fargo Rotary's 3 year commitment to this project has gotten it off of the ground. The need is greater than the current population being served. The Great Plains Food Bank has many volunteer groups and individuals stepping up to assist and ensure that the program grows and is sustained.

Feedback from educators tells the story. Many children in the program come to school Monday morning prepared to learn and are better able to focus on school thanks to the nourishment available over the weekend.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? The Great Plains Food Bank has the primary role of administering the program, including providing the food, determining the menu, organizing community volunteers, delivering the meals to the schools and coordinating with the schools.
