Tournament Participation

The golf tournament is a three-day, 54-hole event open to both men and women. Three divisions, based on handicaps, are formed to accommodate various skill levels. To promote acquaintances and fellowship, a two-person team competition adds another element of interest and commentary to the tournament. Stableford scoring minimizes the frustration of the occasional blowup holes!

A 36-hole, two-day tournament is available for less active golfers.

On the final night at the Gala Awards Banquet, the national Rotary champion and division winners are honored with special trophies unique to that particular venue.

In order to participate in the tournament, a player must:

- a) Be a member of USGFR in good standing;
- b) Have a certified handicap (Index preferred);
- c) Be a spouse or guest of a participating USGFR member;
- d) Be a non-U.S. citizen or a non-U.S. resident who is a member in good standing of IGFR or another recognized Rotary Golfing Fellowship.

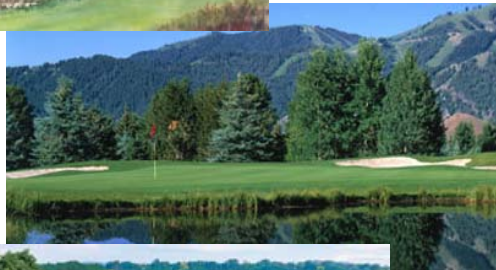

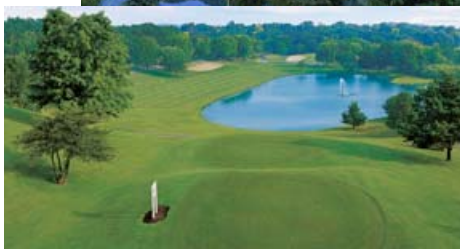
