GRANT APPLICATION INFORMATION

The Topeka Rotary Foundation (TRF) was established by Rotary Club of Topeka for the purpose of encouraging and promoting charitable, benevolent and educational activities and projects benefitting the city of Topeka and Shawnee County.

For FY ending June 30, 2014, TRF will be awarding 3-5 grants for a total of approximately \$18,000 for the purpose of improving the Quality of Life as defined in Heartland Visioning project in the Shawnee County area.

This includes:

- Arts, Culture, Recreation and Entertainment,
- Public Health & Public Safety
- Social Services

Funding Guidelines

- Each applicant is to be a 501 (c) (3) organization or other tax exempt entity (with proof of status).
- Each applicant must adhere to the formal application process.
- Applications will only be accepted during the grant application period: August 1 to September 30, 2013.
- Topeka Rotary Foundation will only fund projects within Shawnee County.
- Major capital projects will not be funded through the Topeka Rotary Foundation. Capital projects are defined as the purchase of land, land improvements or buildings, the construction of land improvements or buildings, and the renovation of buildings.
- Applicants are to follow the specific format provided on our website - topekarotary.org.
- Collaborative applications and start up projects will be given priority.
