



Rotary Club of Beloit Scholarship Fund 2012

The Rotary Club of Beloit will award multiple \$2,000 scholarships this spring to high school seniors wishing to further their education. Of these scholarships, at least one will be awarded to a candidate furthering his/her education in a certified technical or two-year program. Students from Beloit Memorial High School, Beloit Turner High School, and Rock County Christian School, and home-schooled students are eligible for the Rotary Club of Beloit Scholarships.

Listed below are the qualifications, instructions, and procedures candidates are to follow in order to be considered as a recipient. This scholarship is a one time only opportunity for graduating seniors seeking financial assistance in their first year of post-secondary study.

Qualifications:

1. Applicants must display outstanding character and leadership ability.
2. Applicants should evidence a deep sense of obligation to the community.
3. Applicants must present a post-secondary plan for furthering their education (Rotary Scholarship Application, Question #4).

Instructions:

1. Complete Rotary Scholarship Application form by April 13, 2012. The application is not complete without the signature of the school principal (parent in the case of home-school student).
2. Attach three letters of recommendation: one from your counselor or principal, one from a teacher, and one from an adult other than an educator or relative.
3. The completed application and three references should be sent to:
