

2010/2011 District Simplified Grant Awardees

BERLIN--Enhance Zobel Park with new and specialized equipment in a specific area to provide a welcoming environment for those with handicaps.

BURLINGTON--Purchase 40 Sawyer One water buckets with filters at a cost of \$50 each, that includes the cost of hiring a Haitian to deliver them to families in the mountain area of Amazons.

ELMBROOK--Provide vocational and life skill training for handicapped youth and young adults in the Elmbrook school district.

HARTFORD--Install water treatment in San Rafael, Santa Rosa, Chiquimulilla, Guatemala.

HARTLAND LAKE COUNTRY—Provide short-term dental care and pain relief for the people of the lower central plateau in Haiti.

KENOSHA WEST--Provide "play yards" in conjunction with United Way and Department of Health in Kenosha County.

MEQUON THIENSVILLE SUNRISE--Plant 150 Redbud trees along one of the segments of the Rotary Riverwalk which parallels the Milwaukee River.

MILWAUKEE DOWNTOWN—Provide a borehole for clean water for Jollivet (South of Durban/Africa).

MILWAUKEE NORTH SHORE--Feed the homeless in Milwaukee in conjunction with the Univ. of Philipines Alumni Assoc of WI.

MILWAUKEE NORTH SUNRISE--Purchase computer software for children 3-12 years of age attending Silver Spring Neighborhood Center's Early Childhood Education Center that will enhance their math and literacy skills.

MITCHELL FIELD--Sponsor and participate in an In District Day Camp in partnership with the Boy Scouts of America, Southshore District.

PLYMOUTH--Add computer and various developmental programs to improve preschool literacy.

RACINE FOUNDERS--Help renovate a home for homeless young adults age 18 through 21 in Racine.

RIPON--Drill a well to provide clean fresh water to an orphanage in Kenya.

WALWORTH FONTANA--Purchase and distribute food to poor, and orphaned children attending Hopewell Junior Academy and Hopewell Secondary School.

WAUKESHA SUNRISE--Expand capacity to serve low income registrants of the Waukesha County Food Pantry as well as partner and help Food Pantry move to a new facility.

WEST ALLIS--Bring food and school supplies into homes in our community where families live in poverty and are unable to provide these necessities.

WEST BEND NOON--Build composting toilets for human waste which can be converted into garden fertilizer in Haiti.

WEST BEND SUNRISE--Provide educational information through English classes and computer training at Casa Guadalupe Education Center in West Bend.
