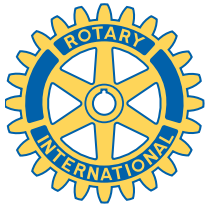

## El Salvador water project

Pastor Chris Stephens gave us a presentation on an international project we have agreed to help fund that is organized by Gurnee resident Megan Gregory, a Peace Corps Volunteer in western El Salvador.

The project is to provide a solar panel system to provide the energy needed to pump water from a well to a storage tank to supply water to a small village of about 120 families. Total cost of the project is \$83,000 but contributions from local Rotary Clubs totaling \$16,600 can leverage additional matching grants from Rotary International to fund the project. Chris said our club needs to determine what our contribution will be.

In addition, we can also help purchase filtration and purification systems by adopting a family for a \$100 contribution. The water is contaminated and needs to be filtered. Members who wish to make individual contributions toward adopting a family for a water filter should bring a check on July 19.
