3. Applicant must have been accepted to an accredited college, university, or vocational institution.
4. Applicant must not be a dependent of a Rotarian, unless they have 2-years of service in Interact Club.

Application Process

Required application items to be submitted:

1. Applicant Information.
2. Parent/Guardian Information.
3. Answer Application Questions A, B, C and D.
4. Two Letters of Recommendation from school teachers and/or members of community.
5. Verification that applicant has been accepted for school admittance.
