1. What it means to a Rotarian?

The Rotarian has given \$ 1000.00 to the Rotary Foundation.

- As one check or through credit card
- Sent money to TRF over a period through Global Contribution Form, and gets Paul Harris Fellow recognition when it amounts to \$1000.00
- TRF direct is another way of getting PHF recognition when it amounts to \$1000.00
- Every Rotarian Every Year credit and sustaining member credit get applied towards Paul Harris Fellowship.
- If you pay \$600.00 to TRF and the club transfers it's credit of 400 points or another Rotarian transfers his or her unused credit of 400 points, you get Paul Harris Fellow recognition.

It is a good way for the clubs to get more Paul Harris Fellows, if the clubs have unused credits available.

2. What it means to a club?

The club has sent money to the Rotary Foundation, has not asked for recognition in the past, and can make use of that credit any time in the future. This money is directly sent to the Foundation's Annual Giving, to Polio or for the Matching Grants as club's contribution. What can club do with it?

- Can recognize any Rotarian in the club or a non-Rotarian in the community as a Paul Harris Fellow.
- Can donate the points to the members partially, members can add dollars to that to make it 1000 points and get recognized as a Paul Harris Fellow. This is a good way of getting more money to the Foundation.
