## Help Rotary to End Polio

Mrs. Lydia Whittaker knows all about polio. Now in her sixties, she has lived with the pain of this disease since she was just a three-month-old baby. At the time, the doctor thought it was a growth issue, rather than polio.

"The doctors in Puerto Rico couldn't figure out why my left leg was drawing up and thought it was some sort of injury at birth as opposed to polio," she explained. "It wasn't until she was in her thirties that a doctor in Texas told her the problem was polio."

Polio is a contagious viral illness that, in its most severe form, causes paralysis, difficulty breathing and sometimes death. In the U.S., the last case of naturally occurring polio happened in 1979. Today, despite a concerted global eradication campaign, poliovirus continues to affect children and adults in Afghanistan, India, Nigeria and Pakistan.

Despite the pain and a slight limp, Mrs. Whittaker has never made polio slow her down. She is married and has three grown children, five grandchildren and is employed. Nevertheless, she wouldn't want anyone to have to experience the pain that she has had throughout the years and she is pleased that organisations such as Rotary Sunrise and Rotary International are doing their part to ensure that polio is eradicated.

With the help of the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, if Rotary raises \$200 million dollars the Gates Foundation will match the amount with \$355 million in challenging grants. The resulting \$555 million supports immunisation campaigns in developing countries where polio continues to infect and paralyse children, robbing them of their future and compounding the hardships faced by their families.

"As long as polio threatens even one child anywhere in the world, children everywhere remain at risk, as polio is very contagious. So I am asking people who see the 'End Polio Now' donation boxes at post offices or at the Hollywood Theater in Camana Bay, please drop your change in," Mrs. Whittaker said. "Every little bit helps," she added.

Rotary Sunrise president Andrea Bryan explained Rotary's mission and why it has worked. "As a result of a massive, global vaccination campaign over the past 20 years, polio exists only in a few countries in Africa and Asia."

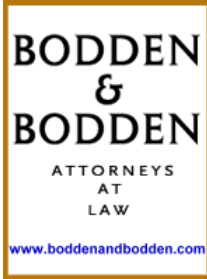
"Rotary has a mission to wipe out polio, but this goal can only be achieved with everyone's help. All we are asking for a small donation - your spare change," Ms. Bryan said.
