These islands offer the visitor an entire gamut of action, adventure, history and beauty.

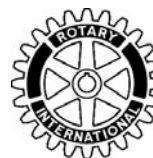

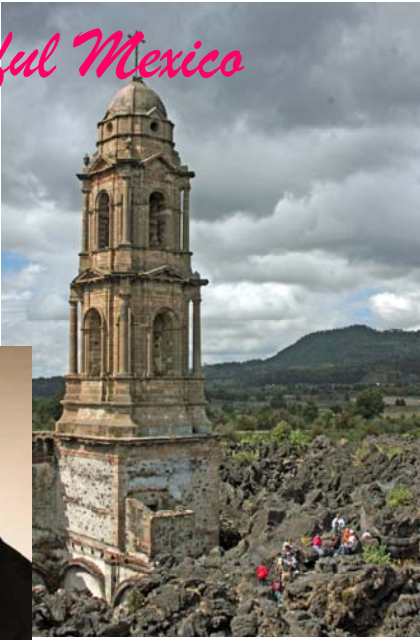
