

ROTARY DOG WALK JUNE 6

A fun and leisurely heritage walk through Tavistock with your favourite canine friend is planned for Sunday, June 6, 2010 beginning at 2:00 p.m. The Rotary Club of Tavistock has put together a Heritage Dog Walk on the Sunday following the World Crokinole Championship and village-wide garage sales.

With an historic route around the village planned through the cooperation of the Tavistock and District Historical Society, participants will have ten viewing stations in which to get a glimpse of Tavistock then and now. Picture boards will mark the viewing locations and watering stations will also be available.

The starting location is the Tavistock Museum/Archives at 37 Maria Street (beside the Library) with the registration desk opening at 1:30 p.m. The first 100 registrants will receive a dog bandana and doggie bag as well as a route map with historical highlights. The registration fee is \$10 with proceeds to the work of the Tavistock Rotary and its partners. Along with the Historical Society, Rotarians will be assisted by the Perth County SPCA and the Oxford 4-H Association.
