District 7210 Vocational Service Award

- have shown outstanding achievement in their vocation by encouraging high ethical standards
- dignified that vocation as an opportunity to serve society

Specifically, the nominee must have provided a service or carried out an act, or acts, **above and beyond normal job duties** and have stimulated change and/or made a difference within the community.

Note: Excellence in Community Service does not come under the conditions of this award. The Vocational Service must be evident in the direct activity and/or contribution by the individual nominated and not merely occur as a result of a profession or membership in an organization.
