Presentations are limited to 30 minutes or less and must meet specific criteria which include the following:

1. Is it presented in a way that is entertaining?
2. Is it topical?
3. Is it of interest to the members?
4. Is it NOT a sales pitch or a plea for money?
5. Is it culturally diverse and non-political?
6. Is there some connection to Rotary?
7. Does it meet the 4-way test?

Rotary uses the "4-Way Test" as an instrument to develop respect and understanding among peoples. This 24-word code of ethics is

- 1. Is it the TRUTH?
- 2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
- 3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
- 4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

Meetings are held weekly on Thursdays from Noon to 1:30PM at the West Chester Golf and Country Club located at 111 W Ashbridge St, West Chester, PA 19380. The program part of the meeting occurs between approximately 12:45 and 1:15PM. The facility is equipped with a projector, screen and microphone system. The projector is able to accept a standard 15 Pin VGA cable, RGB Cable, or RCA composite input.
