1. Will the grant be serving persons in the Farmington/Unionville area or internationally?
2. Does the grant specifically relate to...
 - a. improving project participants' educational opportunities?
 - b. improving project participants' vocational training opportunities/
 - c. improving project participants' physical, emotional and mental well-being?
3. Does the project address acute and/or unmet needs in the community?
4. Does the project involve other volunteer and/or charitable organizations in its efforts?
5. Will project personnel guarantee that Rotary is kept informed of project progress, and as appropriate, make progress reports?

Please note: All proposals in excess of \$100.00 must have Board approval. The approval process is approximately 30 days from the receipt of the proposal.
