Supplemental Instructions:

District Activity:

A District event: includes Foundation events, PR events, membership events, Bandy Hefler events, District Training Seminars, etc.) it does not include regular district committee meetings.

Presidential Citation: All items on the Presidential Citation must be completed to qualify for these points

RI Convention in Bangkok Thailand: Only give yourself 25 points for each "Rotarian" that attends the RI Convention

Sponsor an Interact or Roteract Club: Take the 100 points for either a new club your club sponsored this year or for a club you helped start a number of years ago and are still working with during this Rotary year.

Sponsor a Student to RYLA: Since the 2012 RYLA forum will not have been held when these applications must be submitted we will use the June 2011 RYLA forum. Give yourself 25 points for each student, alternate, or student coordinator that actually attended the event.

ESSEX Student: Some clubs are sponsoring students (incoming or outgoing) for the 2011-2012 year or are committed to sponsoring a student (incoming or outgoing) for the 2012-2013 Rotary year. Give yourself 200 points for each students you are or will sponsor (incoming or outgoing) in either of these Rotary years

Dues: Your club is billed twice a year July and January. If you pay the invoice within 30 days of being invoiced give yourself 50 points for each of these six month invoices. If your club pays the invoice between 31 and 59 days you do not get any points. If your club pays the invoice 60 days or later you lose 50 points for each invoice you pay after that date.

Public Image

Cable TV Show: If your cable TV company runs a show with Rotary as its main topic and one or more members of your club is one of the featured participants of this show then give yourself 100 points for each different cable show they run. NOTE: Having the Cable company run a Rotary Video or show a public service announcement does not count for this item.

The Rotary Foundation

Nominate an Ambassadorial Scholar: If your club sponsored a candidate for an ambassadorial scholarship whether or not they actually made it but they were interviewed by the district committee give yourself 50 points for each scholar you nominated.

GSE Team: If your club hosted one or more members of the incoming GSE Team give yourself 15 points for each team member your club hosted. You do not get additional points if your club sponsored them for more than one day.

Club per capita giving: Per capita giving means taking the total dollar value your club gave between July 1 2011 and April 1, 2012 and dividing it by the number of members in your club as of January 2012. example: a club of 30 members give a total of \$6500 during that time period - the per capita giving for that club is \$216.67 per member (per capita means per member) you would then give yourself 2 points for each dollar of per capita giving = 433.34 points

Club Service

Joint Meeting: If your club formally meets with another club give yourself 25 points for each club you meet with and for each time you meet with them. Don't forget your club counts too so if your club meets with three other clubs once you get 100 points not 75 and if you do this twice you get 200 points

Joint Project: Similar to the joint meetings. Give yourself 25 points for each club (including your own) that you do a joint project with. Do this for each multiple club project your club participates in.
