Awarded at District Conference to the club with the highest per capita contribution to the Australian Rotary Health Fund in the previous year.

The Geoff Tually Perpetual Shield

This shield is awarded to the best inter-club project, ie involving at least two clubs, one of which must be in District 9780

The Lange Trophy

This trophy is awarded at District Conference to the club with the greatest nett growth in the previous year.

Environmental Good Practice Award.

Rotary Clubs are encouraged to submit nominations for environmental Good practice Awards in the categories of:

- A. Government and Business
- B. Community based – not for profit, including Rotary Clubs.

The Awards in 2009-2010 will focus on environmental good practice with a special emphasis on water related issues although any other area on environmental best practice will not be excluded.

District Heritage Award

Rotary Clubs are encouraged to submit projects they have completed which have aided or will aid their communities in the preservation of its cultural heritage. They are encouraged to endeavour to involve local historical societies, shrines or other relevant bodies.

These awards will be presented at District Conference made on a merit basis and will not necessarily be presented annually.
