New Member Red Badge Program

The purpose of the Red Badge Program is to provide you with a quick means to gain familiarity with club activities, to learn more about Rotary, get to know as many members of possible, and become actively involved in a club committee. Upon completing these tasks, your red badge will be replaced with an official Rotary Blue Badge.

The following requirements are composed of seven (7) activities to earn your Blue Badge, four (4) of which are required by the club.

Required Activities – these four (4) activities are required

- Serve as a Greeter for two (2) meetings
- Join a committee
- Meet with your assigned mentor outside of a regularly scheduled club meeting
- Complete two (2) months of perfect attendance (make-ups will be included)

Additional Requirements – complete any three (3) of the following activities

- Give the invocation and pledge
- Attend another Rotary Club's meeting
- Give a classification talk
- Attend a board meeting
- Bring a prospective member to a Rotary meeting
- Participate in a club project
- Attend a club social event
- View the History of Rotary video located on the website
- Tour Webb Elementary
