

Rotary Club of Bastrop County Succession Plan

The Rotary Club of Bastrop County officer succession plan is as follows:

Committee Chairs:

- Appointed by the President Elect for the coming Rotary year
- Committee chairs are expected to serve in that capacity for a period of two years or have previously served as a committee chair.
- Committee membership is determined by the committee chair.
 - Each committee is to have an assistant chair.
 - The past committee chair is to also serve as a member unless the past chair fills an officer position as identified below.

Officers:

- Officers are defined as: President, Vice President, Past President, President-elect, Secretary, Treasurer, Sergeant-at-Arms
- Officers serve for a minimum of one-year.
- Any member may serve multiple times as an Officer however; the President's term is limited to a maximum of eighteen consecutive months.
- Officer positions are filled through the following process:
 - The president's position is filled by the President Elect
 - The President Elect Position is filled by the Vice President
 - The Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Sergeant-at-Arms and other board member positions are selected by the President Elect for the coming year
- Officers must have served as a committee chair for at least one-year prior to being select as an officer.
