# Rotary's Darkness to Light Training: The Issue of Child Sexual Abuse

**Think of 4 girls you know.**

Now guess which one will be sexually abused before she's 18.

**Now think of 6 boys you know.**

Which one of them will be sexually abused before he's 18?

**Only 1 of 10 children who are abused will tell someone.**

No one wants to think about it.

That's what abusers of children count on, of course.

*Shame, embarrassment, fear, confusion.*

They keep children silent and adults ignorant.

*They keep truth hidden in the dark.*

**Why should you care?**

It doesn't happen in your town. At your school. In your church.

**Actually, it does.**

*In fact, more than 90% of abusers are people children know, love or trust.*

**What is Darkness to Light?**

It is a training program for responsible organizations and adults interested in the prevention of child sexual abuse. The training program outlines the Darkness to Light core principles for preventing, recognizing, and reacting responsibly to child sexual abuse and form the framework for the adult training program, Stewards of Children.

**Rotary Sunrise's goal?**

To have all of our Rotarian's certified in the Darkness to Light program by 2012. To date we have 12 Rotarians who are certified, 88 more to go!!
