Heartily welcome Rotarians Stacy and Chris into the Family of Rotary!

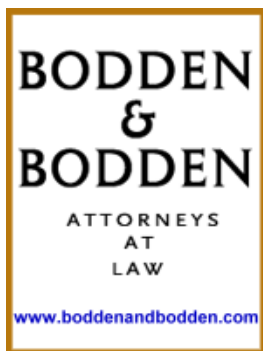

## Sunrise Thanks Camana Bay



As partners in the Rotary Sunrise PolioPlus public awareness and fundraising effort earlier this year, Camana Bay was instrumental in helping our club collect more than \$16,000 to battle the crippling childhood disease. Camana Bay permitted the "End Polio Now" logo to be projected upon a prominent building and actively

encouraged the club's charitable solicitations.

Eradication of polio has been Rotary's priority for more than two decades and Kenneth Hydes, Camana Bay's Town Centre Manager, expressed his company's pleasure in being able to support Rotary Sunrise with this humanitarian endeavor. In return, PolioPlus Chair Tony Catalonotto and President Michael presented a plaque of appreciation to Mr. Hydes on behalf of all the Rotary Sunrise members.

## Guest Speaker: Natalie Urquhart

Natalie has been the Director of the National Gallery of the Cayman Islands since 2009 having joined the Gallery as education officer in 2002. Natalie has driven many initiatives and programs for youth and artists including collaborations with Rotary Sunrise, Rotary Club Grand Cayman, CINA, the National Museum, CNCF and the National Trust among others. Prior to joining the National Gallery as a staff member, she volunteered as PR Chairperson of Friends of the Gallery. In 2008 she launched the Cayman Contemporary Arts Initiative, a Caymanian artist cooperative and arts administration body that provides free arts education for emerging and established Cayman based artists.

Natalie participated in Mentorship Cayman in 2009 and was inspired to create a specialised mentorship program for young artists and performers, scheduled to launch in September 2011. Natalie was awarded the Cayman Islands Cultural Scholarship in 2005 and was recently recognised for her long-standing contribution to culture at the 2010 National Arts and Culture Awards where she received a Star of Creativity. She was selected to join the Leadership Cayman inaugural class, graduating in July 2010, and she remains involved as a member of the program's planning committee.



Natalie is an active member of the National Museum, the National Trust, VAS, and CISHRP. She serves as a public and private sector advisor on cultural matters and has presented papers on Caymanian arts and culture at home and abroad.
