Guest Speaker: DGN Jeremy Hurst

DGN Jeremy S. Hurst will address the Sunrise Club on the topic of "What it Means to be a Rotarian" at Wednesday's meeting.

DGN Jeremy was born on December 4, 1961 in Rochester, UK. Nationality: Caymanian / British. He was educated at Sir Joseph Williamson's Mathematical School Rochester and University College, University of London with a BSc. Hons. Degree in Land Development Studies

DGN Jeremy's career started at Vickers PLC, London from 1983 - 87 as a Team Manager and Southern Region Special Projects Manager. He then went to Columbus Ltd. – 1988 - 1990 as General Manger, followed by RJR Ltd. from 1990 -1994. In 1994 he moved to R C Bodden Realty Ltd. since and is currently the Sales Director. DGN Jeremy formed the International Relocation Group Ltd. (IRG) in 1994, which has developed into a group of companies providing property and relocation services to corporations and high net worth investors.

DGN Jeremy joined the Rotary Club of Grand Cayman in 1989 and quickly moved up through the ranks serving on the Board of Directors as Fundraising and Vocational Services Director from 1991-1993, VP and PE in 1993-94 and 1994-5 respectively, and as President in 1995-96. DGN Jeremy was the Assistant Governor to the Cayman Islands Rotary Clubs from 2000 to 2003 and is a multiple Paul Harris Fellow to Major Donor Level. He is also a Member of the Paul Harris Society, and a Foundation Sustaining Member and Benefactor.

As Club Foundation Chair/Committee Member from 2004 to present he assisted in raising over \$100,000 for the Foundation. DGN Jeremy served as Chairman of 2000-1 District Conference and Co-Chair of 2006-7 District Conference.

They are all most welcome additions to our group. - Determine with the committee if we should continue with the Bright Start Program.
 - Since mentioning that we may cut this program, several people have come forward to assist so that we can keep this program alive.
- Continue to support CALS
 - George Town Primary will do a pilot project when school starts back in September. If they are happy with their pilot program we could really get entrenched with the Government schools and have a great opportunity to make strides to reduce the illiteracy in the Cayman Islands
- Continue to co-run the Fred Speirs Inter School Debates with Central
- Continue with one on one reading at Clifton Hunter and George Town Primary
- Supply Character Development Books which incorporates the 4 Way Test to elementary school children
- Provide 1st year high school students with dictionaries
- Sponsor a teaching award for graduates of UCCI
- Have a book selling booth at the annual Agriculture Show on Ash Wednesday
