## MEMBERSHIP Helping to Grow Our Club

...A Membership Month Article...

All Rotarians are ambassadors of Rotary and their clubs. This is especially relevant during Membership and Extension Month in August, when the focus is on building strong, vibrant clubs by inviting prospective members to join Rotary.

One of the hottest topics for clubs is how to retain current members. Clubs often lose numerous members for various reasons such as lack of interest or lack of time to commit.

This Rotary year, President Andrea and her board have committed to growing our membership from 93 to 95 by June 30th, 2012. Although the net number is small, due to the transient nature of our club, based on the historical fall-out we will need to add at least 6 new members to end up with +2 net new members.

In order to accomplish this goal, listed below are our club's plans and related action steps as outlined in our Planning Guide for this Rotary Year as submitted by President Adrea to District prior to the start of her Rotary Year.

### Our Club's Plans:

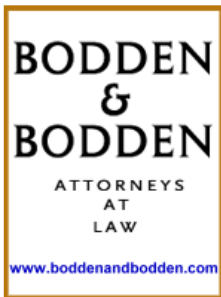
- Develop a retention plan that focuses on maintaining high levels of enthusiasm through participation in interesting programs, projects, continuing education and fellowship activities.
- Ensure the membership committees are aware of effective recruitment techniques.
- Develop a recruitment plan to have the club reflect the diversity of the community.
- Explain the expectations of membership to potential Rotarians.
- Assign an experienced Rotarian mentor to every new club member.
- Recognize those Rotarians who sponsor new members.
- Be more selective in recruitment and seek out persons who are actively demonstrating a willingness to be of service.

### Action Steps:

- Reintroduce "Getting to Know You" talks from more longer-serving members of the club for the benefit of newer members in particular.
- Survey members for those hobbies/skills which they are willing to contribute to the club's projects/programmes and produce an inventory of skills and/or hobbies.
- Conduct mini-fora and surveys at club meetings once per month to better understand what members want the club to be and do.
- Groom the next generation of club leaders through early selection, understudy of current leaders, creating opportunities to practice leadership, continuing education, attendance at District and International conferences and other forms of training.
- Set aside funds for training and in support of members who participate in training programmes sponsored by the club e.g. Rotary Leadership Institute.
- Conduct at least one training event each quarter year.
- Continue to engage closely with the Rotaract Club of Grand Cayman to encourage a smooth transition to Rotary Sunrise when they come of age.

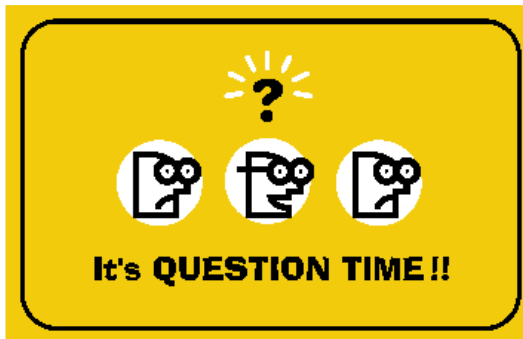
