The monthly theme for November is The Rotary Foundation (TRF). So, you'll hear a lot about TRF in the coming weeks. But in a nutshell, the Foundation is how we as Rotarians can make major changes in the world...changes that exceed the budget of any single Rotary club. PolioPlus is a TRF project. District Designated Funds, such as those that our District is using to rebuild Haiti, are funded through TRF. Economic and community development projects, water and sanitation projects, maternal and health projects...yes, all those and more receive their funding through TRF.



The Paul Harris Society is composed of Rotarians who have pledged to support the good works of The Rotary Foundation by contributing US\$1000 every Rotary year. That sounds like a lot of money, but it really is just CI\$70 a month. And yes, you can become a Paul Harris Society member by contributing on a monthly basis, if you wish. As soon as your donations total US\$1000, District 7020 will send you your PHS recognition ribbon.

You don't have to be a Paul Harris Fellow to join the Society. This is a District 7020 recognition program for local Rotarians. Just complete the form entitled "Paul Harris Society of District 7020" and give it to PP Hendrik or any Board member. If you plan to make installment payments, be sure to check the second box on the form that says: "I pledge to make future


