It started one evening at a Literacy Committee meeting when Director Woody asked for a volunteer to head up a reading programme at the John A. Cumber Primary School in West Bay. As I slid deeper into my chair hoping to slide out of Director Woody's view, I found myself elected to head up the project. Rotarian Pauline saw my look of panic and bewilderment and kindly offered to assist me in setting up the programme. Rotarian Pauline and I met with Principal Joseph Wallace who was very keen and interested in the programme and in no time I was in contact with Mrs. Tasha Porter the Librarian at the School.

I received great response from 10 volunteers from Diamonds International, 8 from word of mouth and 2, Sandra Finnegan and Betsy Kelly, from Rotary. The children are cute and eager to read, and they range between 5 to 7 years of age. The reading is on Mondays, 1pm to 1:30pm, and we are now in the second term of the programme which ends 29th June 2012.

Unfortunately the Diamonds International volunteers could not make the second term due to their work schedules, but Rotarian Sandra and Betsy helped to quickly fill these spots and together with Rotarian Chris Lumsden and Rotarian Guest, Ed Meade, we now have 18 volunteers. Mrs. Porter confirmed that the students were showing improvement in their reading tests.

The annual Cayman Heart Fund Health Fair was held this past weekend at the ARC at Camana Bay. The fair ran from 8:30 to 2:00pm and was enjoyed by a record number of visitors this year.

The past five years Rotary Sunrise has assisted the Cayman Heart Fund by volunteering its members to assist with the Kiddies Corner. This year the Heart Fund organizing committee wanted to try something new. Knowing that poor eating habits and lack of exercise generally starts at home, the committee wanted to target the youth of Cayman by getting them active. Dr. Christine Chen a local Pediatrician worked with the Rotary Sunrise Community Service committee to embellish the Kiddies Corner.



Children were instructed to visit Dr. Chridland's table inside the ARC to get registered and have their height, weight and body mass index measurements taken. Each child then received a Get Active Passport and made their way to the Kiddies Corner which in effect was the CIS playground area. A stage and a few tents for shade were set up to host a number of demonstrations held by Jackie's School of Dance, Cross Fit Kids and Zumba. As the children engaged in the activities Rotarians were there to stamp their passports. Children could also receive stamps for participating in the gaming centres set up and monitored by Rotary Sunrise members.

The gaming centres featured soccer, bocce, hockey and football. The more active the children were, the more stamps they received. In the end the children turned in their passports for sports prizes ranging from a few dollars to as high as fifty dollars. Rotary Sunrise provided the prizes which were heavily discounted by Sports Supply while Dr. Chen was active in collecting donations for prizes and gift certificates from local stores on the island.
