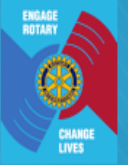

## Ways to Donate to the Foundation

November is Rotary Foundation month. With the Christmas holidays approaching so soon, I would like every Rotarian's consideration to donate to the Foundation. If you decide to do so, please donate to the Annual Fund or to Polio Plus. Part of the donations to the Annual Fund come back to our District, so it helps District 7020 with its community service.



In this article I briefly explain the **3 ways that you can donate**. It does not matter so much which method you use, because all donations go to the Foundation. **The first way is to make your donation through Sunrise.** All you need to do is approach Treasurer John or me and indicate whether your donation is for the Annual Fund or for Polio Plus. John will deposit your funds in the club account and transfer the funds to the Foundation in your name and we will do the paperwork. **The second way is to do this yourself by downloading the Rotary Foundation Contribution Form from the Rotary.org website**, purchase a bankdraft payable to the Foundation and mail it in along with the completed form. **The third way is Rotary Direct**, which makes donations very easy through a credit card payment. The Rotary website <https://map.rotary.org/en/selfservice/pages/SelectFundF.aspx?FUND=APF> will show you what to do and you can donate any way you want: monthly or annual payment with a standing order for your credit card, or a one-time credit card payment. The Foundation appreciates credit card payments through Rotary Direct, as this has the lowest administrative fees.

All donations that you make will be credited to your Rotary account. One dollar is one point. You can access your personal account by logging into <https://www.rotary.org/myrotary/en/home>.

Next week's article will highlight the recognition that Rotary gives for your donation.

## Getting Back to the Business of FUN

Stay-Focused offers a unique, transformational learning experience to teens and young adults with disabilities. Through a SCUBA certification program, participants gain confidence, develop leadership skills, become more

independent, and join the Stay-Focused community. Participants learn to challenge themselves, set higher goals, and form long-term relationships. Stay-Focused is committed to supporting medical research that explores the beneficial aspects of diving on persons with mobility challenges.

Roger Muller, Founder/President, worked in both academia and the business world before committing to his passion of creating an organization that would provide teens with a unique learning experience. On a diving trip to Grand Cayman in 2000, Roger dived with his brother Bobby, a Marine Corps combat veteran and a paraplegic as a result of an injury sustained in Vietnam. Seeing how much Bobby enjoyed the freedom of diving, Roger decided Stay-Focused would be dedicated to offering teens with disabilities the same opportunity to enjoy the water that his brother had experienced.

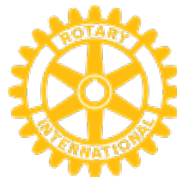
