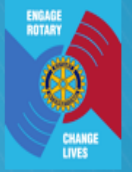

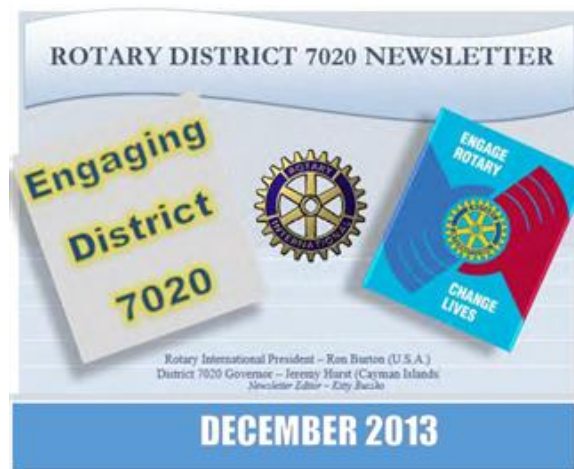
Building Our Future with Vision

Have you read the District 7020 newsletter, lately?

But it isn't so much the mechanics of the publication that make it such a great communication tool. It's the content!

Two years later, he accepted Rotary's highest award, the Rotary Award for World Understanding. In true fashion, he donated the \$100,000 grant accompanying the award to the Nelson Mandela Children's Fund.

Rotary is especially grateful for his strong support of the global effort to eradicate the crippling disease polio, our organization's highest priority. Mr. Mandela himself helped administer oral polio vaccine to the children of South Africa, which has been declared polio-free.

Our deepest condolences go to Mr. Mandela's family, to his millions of admirers worldwide, and especially to the People of South Africa, including the country's Rotary members, who knew him as a friend and staunch supporter of humanitarian service.

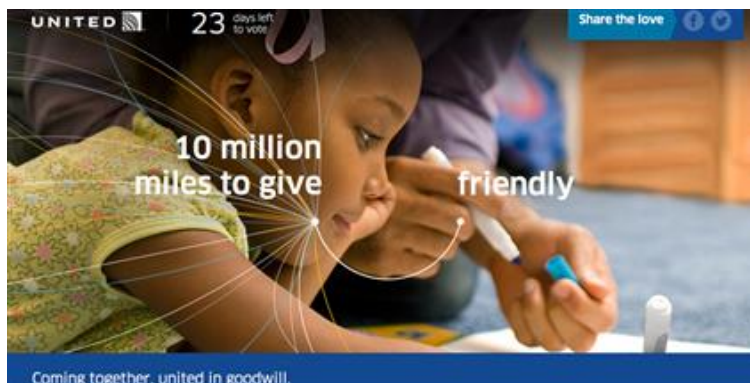

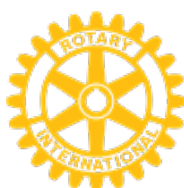
Library discussing CALS and **President JD** who will round out the group. The show promises to be very engaging and educational so we encourage everyone to tune in.
