

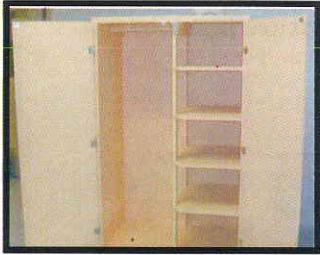

Rebuilding Lives By Building Furniture



HONOR Industries is a unique Affirmative "Family" Business which provides permanent jobs, competitive

wages, career tracks and ownership opportunities for the most disenfranchised people in our communities. This special family is made up of the homeless, developmentally disabled, mentally ill, recovering substance abusers and others who have grappled with and conquered many personal challenges.

HONOR Industries is a Division of HON-OREhg, a 40 year old not-for-profit Agency providing shelter and crisis care for Homeless men, women, adolescents and families with children in our residential programs. The employees of our business continue to flow out of our shelter programs and are offered training, nurturing, jobs and economic independence and self-sufficiency. They have become members of the HONOR family, are meaningfully employed and part of a team and a vision which continues to help others who are in the same position they were in. They are not only valued workers but mentors. HONOR Industries is the result of the creative common vision of our Voluntary Board of Directors who decided that the time has come to

courageously address long term solutions for the Homeless and not simply treat the symptoms. Their only compensation is the joy of witnessing lives being rebuilt.



HONOR Industries simultaneously pursues returns on investment in three areas: Social, Financial and Environmental.

Social: Through adult living skills training, employment skills training and internship mentoring the most unemployable attain a high level of employability, professionalism and productivity and are offered jobs within the Business.

Financial: Through the production, marketing and sales of our community setting wood furniture (beds, dressers, end tables, wardrobes, storage cabinets), we enjoy a profit but all profits are used to grow the business so that more jobs can be created for the ever growing number of homeless. All furniture is made from 3/4 birch plywood. The storage cabinet is biscuited, glued and nailed together. All other furniture pieces are dadoed, rabbited, nailed and glued together. This construction ensures incredible durability and lifetime satisfaction.

Environmental: Through leveraging a portion of our profits with federal, state, local and private foundation funding sources (grants) we acquire and rehabilitate vacated, abandoned and boarded up housing units in the most blighted areas of our community. These units are offered for home ownership to the employees of HONOR Industries with no interest "loans" at exactly the cost of acquisition and rehabilitation. As these "mortgages" are paid off we use the proceeds to buy and rehab yet other units for future home ownership.

"I would never smile or talk. I wasn't a people person. Now I talk and laugh all the time. We have all learned teamwork. By this I mean that we all have to contribute something to make something and when we finish a piece of furniture we have such a sense of accomplishment. We just want to celebrate. Most of us have never felt like this before."
